NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 13 The original or historical routing of State Highway 69 is part 14 15 of the historic Jefferson Highway Association Route, which was one of the earliest automobile highways in the United States. The route 16 once ran north to south from Winnipeg, Canada to New Orleans, 17 Louisiana and spanned over two thousand three hundred (2,300) miles 18 and through seven states. The entire historic route, including the 19 Oklahoma portion, has recently been reidentified by the reformed 20 Jefferson Highway Association organization. 21 A new section of law to be codified SECTION 2. NEW LAW 22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless 23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1	State Highway 69 from the Kansas border to the Texas border
2	shall be designated as the "Historic Jefferson Highway Route". The
3	cost associated with signage required by this section shall be
4	provided from private sources and shall include the cost of the
5	initial erection of signs as well as the cost of potential
6	replacement or reconstruction of signs. Upon receiving adequate
7	funding from private sources, the Department of Transportation shall
8	cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
9	bearing that name. The permanent markers shall be designed in
10	consultation with the Jefferson Highway Association.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
