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6	An Act relating to state government; repealing 74 O.S. 2011, Section 841.30, as amended by Section 922,
7	Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 841.30), which relates to the Oklahoma Compensation
8	and Unclassified Positions Review Board; providing for submission of requests for unclassified positions
9	and employees for Legislative approval; providing for submission of requests for reclassification of
10	certain positions and employees for Legislative approval; providing deadlines for reviewing requests;
11	prohibiting resubmitting of certain identical requests; exempting certain requests from cutoff
12	dates; limiting provisions in certain concurrent resolution provisions; providing for certain omnibus
13	concurrent resolution; providing for certain authorization; prohibiting addition or
14	reclassification of certain positions and employees without Legislature approval; providing for
15	codification; and providing an effective date.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Section 841.30, as
20	amended by Section 922, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.
21	2018, Section 841.30), is hereby repealed.
22	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-5.27 of Title 74, unless
24	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 State agencies subject to the provisions of the Merit System Α. of Personnel Administration shall submit requests to the 2 3 subcommittee of the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State Senate under whose jurisdiction the state agency resides for 4 5 authorizations to add unclassified positions and employees to the state service that are in addition to unclassified positions already 6 7 authorized by law. The Legislature may approve or disapprove the request by the proper passage of a concurrent resolution introduced 8 9 by the chair or vice-chair of the subcommittee.

10 State agencies subject to the provisions of the Merit System Β. of Personnel Administration shall submit requests to the 11 12 subcommittee of the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State 13 Senate under whose jurisdiction the state agency resides for authorizations for reclassification of current positions and 14 15 employees in the state service not already specified as classified 16 or unclassified by law. The Legislature may approve or disapprove the request by the proper passage of a concurrent resolution 17 introduced by the chair or vice-chair of the subcommittee. 18

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C. Except as otherwise provided by this section:

If the requests are received on or before April 1, the
 Legislature shall have until the last day of the regular legislative
 session of that year to review the requests; and

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2. If the requests are received after April 1, the Legislature
 shall have until the last day of the regular legislative session of
 the next year to review the requests.

D. Unless otherwise authorized by the Legislature, whenever a
request is disapproved as provided in subsection A or B of this
section, the agency submitting the request shall not have authority
to resubmit an identical request, except during the first sixty (60)
calendar days of the next regular legislative session.

9 Ε. Unless otherwise provided by specific vote of the 10 Legislature, concurrent resolutions introduced for purposes of approving or disapproving a request or the omnibus concurrent 11 resolution described in subsection F of this section shall not be 12 13 subject to regular legislative cutoff dates, shall be limited to such provisions as may be necessary for disapproval or approval of a 14 request, and any such other direction or mandate regarding the 15 request deemed necessary by the Legislature. The resolution shall 16 17 contain no other provisions.

F. The Legislature may have an omnibus concurrent resolution prepared for consideration each session. The concurrent resolution shall be substantially in the following form: "All requests for authorizations for adding unclassified positions and employees to the state service that are in addition to unclassified positions already authorized by law from Oklahoma state agencies filed on or before April 1 are hereby approved except for the following:" or

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"All requests for authorizations for reclassification of current positions and employees in the state service not already specified as classified or unclassified by law from Oklahoma state agencies filed on or before April 1 are hereby approved except for the following:". For the purpose of this section, a request may be disapproved, in whole or in part, in the omnibus concurrent resolution considered by the Legislature.

G. Upon proper passage of the concurrent resolution introduced 8 9 for purposes of approving a request pursuant to subsection A or B of 10 this section, the request shall be authorized to commence. No state 11 agency subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel 12 Administration shall add an unclassified position or employee to the state service in addition to unclassified positions already 13 authorized by law unless it has been approved pursuant to this 14 section or other provision of law. No state agency subject to the 15 provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration shall 16 17 reclassify a current position or employee in the state service unless it has been approved pursuant to this section or other 18 provision of law. 19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019. 20
