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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.105 of Title 62, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	State agencies shall provide advance notice to the State
17	Treasurer of all disbursements that could negatively impact state
18	cash flow requirements. For purposes of this section, daily total
19	submissions for disbursement equal to or in excess of Twenty-five
20	Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) shall be deemed to have the
21	potential to negatively impact state cash flow. Notice of such
22	disbursements shall be provided to the State Treasurer at least five
23	(5) business days in advance of the issue date of the disbursement.
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1	Provided, payroll disbursements shall not be subject to advance
2	notice required by this section.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
