6 An Act relating to commercial driver licenses;  
7 providing for certain hazardous materials endorsement  
8 exemption; providing for codification; providing an  
9 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.17 of Title 47, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. Any person driving under a commercial Class A license shall  
15 not be required to obtain a hazardous materials endorsement pursuant  
16 to 49 C.F.R. Section 383 if the person is:

17 1. Acting within the scope of the license holder's employment  
18 as an employee of a custom harvester operation, agrichemical  
19 business, farm retail outlet and supplier or livestock feeder;

20 2. Is operating a service vehicle that is transporting diesel  
21 in a quantity of three thousand seven hundred eighty-five (3,785)  
22 liters or one thousand (1,000) gallons or less; and

23 3. Is clearly marked with a "flammable" or "combustible"  
24 placard as appropriate.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
