7 An Act relating to protective services for the
8 elderly and for incapacitated adults; directing the
9 Department of Human Services to require certain
10 training; providing for codification; and providing
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-114 of Title 43A, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The Department of Human Services shall require all Adult
17 Protective Services (APS) specialists to receive training regarding
18 the recognition of individuals with cognitive impairment, effective
19 intervention in cases involving the abuse and exploitation of
20 individuals who are cognitively impaired and securing the safety of
21 abused and exploited individuals with dementia.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
