12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-2, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 6-2. A. The State Board of Agriculture shall be the
16	official livestock and poultry disease control agency of the State
17	of Oklahoma. The Board shall have authority to promulgate and
18	enforce rules governing the handling, sale, and use of vaccines,
19	antigens, and other biological products used in connection with
20	livestock or poultry.
21	B. In addition to other statutory authority, the State
22	Veterinarian, upon obtaining concurrence of the State Board of
23	Agriculture, may issue emergency orders governing animals in order
24	

- 1 to protect the citizens and animals of the state from diseases and 2 pests of animals, including the following to:
- 3 1. Prohibit or impose conditions on importing animals into the 4 state;
 - 2. Require testing of animals;
 - 3. Require vaccination or other treatment of animals;
- 7 4. Prohibit or impose conditions on moving animals within the 8 state;
 - 5. Issue stop movement orders for all livestock in the state to determine the precise location of a foreign animal disease in accordance with foreign animal disease response plans;
 - 6. Govern the disposition of animals; and
- 6. 7. Impose other measures governing animals to protect the citizens and animals of the state from diseases and pests of animals.
 - C. Emergency orders issued pursuant to this section shall expire on the date set in the order or upon the elapse of ninety (90) days; however, the State Veterinarian may renew the order for successive ninety-day periods.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
