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6	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board; creating the Phase II Arbuckle-Simpson
7	Hydrology Study Revolving Fund; stating uses and purpose of the fund; providing for deposits to the
8	fund; limiting certain expenditures; requiring the Board to coordinate with certain entities;
9	authorizing the Board to coordinate with certain entities; providing for codification; providing an
10	effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1085.7C of Title 82, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
18	fund for the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to be designated the
19	"Phase II Arbuckle-Simpson Hydrology Study Revolving Fund".
20	B. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
21	year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
22	Oklahoma Water Resources Board from the appropriations,
23	apportionments, donations, federal grants and fee revenues
24	designated for the purposes of completing in coordination with

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1 relevant state and federal agencies, specifically including the 2 United States Geological Survey, data collection and development of 3 an enhanced hydrologic framework and modeling of the eastern Arbuckle-Simpson Groundwater Basin necessary for purposes of 4 5 implementing the requirements of subsection A of Section 1020.9 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or as otherwise appropriate for 6 the Board's performance of its lawful function, which work is 7 necessary for completion of Phase II of the Arbuckle-Simpson 8 9 Hydrology Study.

10 C. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby 11 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Water 12 Resources Board for the purpose of implementing Phase II of the 13 Arbuckle-Simpson Hydrology Study. The Board shall coordinate with East Central University and the United State Geological Survey for 14 15 the purpose of defining the study scope and conducting the work necessary to complete data collection and the development of an 16 17 enhanced hydrologic framework and modeling of the eastern Arbuckle-Simpson Groundwater Basin necessary for purposes of implementing the 18 requirements of subsection A of Section 1020.9 of Title 82 of the 19 Oklahoma Statutes, or as otherwise appropriate for the Board's 20 performance of its lawful function. The Board may coordinate with 21 other relevant state and federal agencies necessary for the purposes 22 of this fund. 23

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1	D. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
2	issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
3	law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
4	Services for approval and payment.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
