The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma 15 Department of Human Services and Oklahoma Employment Security 16 Commission shall be authorized to require agency employees and the 17 employees of agency contractors in positions that have access to 18 Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and 19 documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal 20 history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as 21 well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through 22 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of 23 Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable 24

1	employer-agency submitting agency shall be the recipient of the
2	results of the record check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of
3	Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, this includes a national criminal
4	record with a fingerprint analysis.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
