6 An Act relating to narcotic treatment programs;
7 amending 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, which relates
8 to medication fee for participation in opioid
9 substitution treatment program; transferring
authority to assess medication fee on certain persons
to opioid substitution treatment program; and
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 3-603. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance
16 Abuse Services shall approve a standard medication fee for persons
17 participating in an opioid substitution treatment program who are
18 recipients of Medicare or Medicaid. An opioid substitution
19 treatment program may assess a medication fee on persons
20 participating in the opioid substitution treatment program who are
21 not recipients of Medicare or Medicaid in an amount determined by
22 the opioid substitution treatment program.

23 B. A person participating in an opioid substitution treatment
24 program shall be terminated from the program if the person fails to

1 participate in counseling sessions or if the person fails to adhere
2 to the program's guidelines as promulgated by the Board.

3 C. The Board is authorized to promulgate such rules as are
4 necessary to implement this act.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
