NEW LAW 11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.580 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 12 13 There is hereby created the Educators' Professional Α. Liability Insurance Program for all employees of public schools, as 14 that term is defined in Section 1-106 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma 15 Statutes, and charter schools, as that term is defined in subsection 16 D of Section 3-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 17 Participation in this program is mandatory for all employees of 18 public schools and charter schools as defined above. 19 20 The program shall provide Educators' Legal Liability Β. including Employment Practices insurance coverage for all employees 21 with a minimum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in coverage 22 23 per occurrence. 24

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C. The program shall be administered by the Office of
 Management and Enterprise Services (OMES). OMES shall promulgate
 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

D. OMES shall be authorized to contract liability insurance
from a licensed insurer to create a self-insured risk pool or to use
a combination of both.

7 E. The insurance carrier providing any portion of coverage
8 provided under this act shall be selected by a competitive process.

9 F. The Legislature shall provide an annual appropriation to10 cover the costs and any associated premiums for the program.

G. Each school district shall notify annually, in writing,
 eligible employees about the coverage provided by the Educators'
 Professional Liability Insurance Program.

H. OMES and the Department of Education shall notify in writing
all eligible employees about the Educators' Professional Liability
Insurance Program. The notice shall specifically inform employees
that coverage is provided automatically as part of their employment.
The notice shall be given upon hiring and annually thereafter.

I. Nothing in this section shall be construed to exempt a local
 school district from any current obligations or duties nor amend the
 Governmental Tort Claims Act provided in Sections 151 through 172 of
 Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

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SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.58R of Title 74, unless there
 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Risk Management Administrator, pursuant to Section
85.58A of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the provisions of
Section 1 of this act, may obtain or provide insurance coverage,
self-insurance or any combination of the two for any school district
requesting loss prevention or insurance services. Insurance
coverage may address or relate to any services provided by school
districts.

B. Coverage available through the Risk Management Department of
the Office of Management and Enterprise Services may include:

Vehicle liability and tort liability, corresponding with the
 Governmental Tort Claims Act provided in Sections 151 through 172 of
 Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

- 16 2. Commercial property insurance;
- 17 3. Fine arts insurance; and

18 4. Any other coverage as requested by a school district.

19 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.58S of Title 74, unless there 21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury an interest bearing revolving fund for the Risk Management Department of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, to be designated the

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1 "Risk Management School District Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 2 3 consist of any monies transferred thereto by an act of the Legislature and any fees collected by the Risk Management Department 4 5 of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in accordance with Section 85.58M of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the 6 provisions of this act. All monies accruing to the credit of the 7 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the 8 9 Risk Management Department of the Office of Management and 10 Enterprise Services for the purposes of the Educators' Professional 11 Liability Program, pursuant to Section 85.58A of Title 74 of the 12 Oklahoma Statutes and the provisions of Section 1 of this act, as 13 herein established for school districts including the salaries and administrative expenses of support staff responsible for 14 15 administering the fund and expenses the Department incurs to support program operations. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon 16 17 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval 18 and payment. 19 20 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019. 21 22 23
