AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 840-5.12, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 64, O.S.L. 2015 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, 13 Section 840-5.12), is amended to read as follows: 14 15 Section 840-5.12. A. The State Department of Rehabilitation 16 Services shall be under the Merit System. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all offices, positions and personnel shall 17 be classified and subject to the provisions of the Merit System of 18 Personnel Administration and rules promulgated hereunder. This 19 section shall supersede and repeal any and all executive orders 20 issued pursuant to Section 840-1.1 et seq. of this title to place 21 the agency or its predecessors under the Merit System. 22 In addition to offices, positions and personnel that are 23 в. unclassified pursuant to Section 840-5.5 of this title, the Director 24

of the State Department of Rehabilitation Services may establish positions in the unclassified service and place employees in the positions provided the total number of unclassified positions does not exceed fifty-two. This limit does not include State Department of Rehabilitation Services employees subject to Section 840-5.3 of this title.

C. The limit on unclassified positions provided for in
subsection B of this section shall not apply to the instructional
and administrative personnel at the Oklahoma School for the Blind
and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf as listed in Section 1419 of
Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 D. The limit on unclassified positions provided for in subsection B of this section shall not apply to the employees of the 13 Disability Determination Division Services of the State Department 14 of Rehabilitation Services. The Director of the State Department of 15 Rehabilitation Services may establish positions in the unclassified 16 service in the Disability Determination Division Services and may 17 place employees in those positions provided the total number of 18 those unclassified positions does not exceed twenty-one. 19

E. Instructional and administrative personnel of the State Department of Rehabilitation Services at the Oklahoma School for the Blind and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf pursuant to Section 1419 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be considered unclassified state employees solely for the purpose of entering and
