7 A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the 2018 Class  
8 4A State Football Champions, the Tuttle High School  
9 Tigers; applauding the 2018 Class 4A State Academic  
10 Champions; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the Tuttle Tigers football team defeated the Bethany  
12 Broncos 35-28 at Yukon High School on November 30, 2018, to win the  
13 Class 4A Football State Championship; and

14 WHEREAS, the Tiger's 14-0 season culminated in the first state  
15 football championship for Tuttle since 2005; and

16 WHEREAS, the team paid tribute to former teammates #3 Cade Boles  
17 and #71 Brady Carlton by carrying their jerseys to the coin toss for  
18 the championship game; and

19 WHEREAS, the Tiger's offense averaged 30 plus points per game.  
20 They allowed only 53 total points in their final four games with  
21 opponents scoring less than 11 points per game and averaging just  
22 under 200 total yards; and

23 WHEREAS, the team's dedication was seen not only on the field  
24 but in the classroom as, for the fifth time in a row, they were

1 named the 2018 Class 4A Academic State Champions with a 3.408  
2 G.P.A.; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tigers also received many individual awards. Head  
4 Coach Brad Ballard was named Coach of the Year and Quarterback  
5 Carson Berryhill won Player of the Year. Linebacker Dylan Coffman  
6 was named The Oklahoman's Little All-City Defensive Player of the  
7 Year and was also a member of the All-State team. Colby Travino was  
8 named Wide Receiver of the Year and Grant Polson won Full Back of  
9 the Year; and

10 WHEREAS, offensive lineman Ian Johnson, wide receiver Camden  
11 Periman and defensive lineman Braden Truelove were named First Team  
12 selections; and

13 WHEREAS, offensive lineman Avery Voyles, wide receiver Jace  
14 Tiderman and outside linebacker Khord Story were Second Team  
15 Honorable Mention selections.
