9 Oklahoma Drug Testing Reform Act; providing for
standards for certain entities; requiring usage of

training qualifications; providing for codification;

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 566 of Title 40, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
18 Drug Testing Reform Act".

19 B. The Oklahoma Drug Testing Reform Act provides the standards
20 for drug and alcohol testing required or requested by employers and
21 for federal, state, county and municipal service providers,
22 including probation and parole service providers, private probation
23 persons, the Department of Corrections, any state-authorized court
24 and community-based treatment programs.

1 C. The entities referenced in subsection B of this section
2 shall be excluded from any additional mandates and shall follow the
3 best practices and guidelines outlined in 49 CFR Part 40. All drug
4 testing shall be conducted by personnel meeting the training
5 qualifications found in 49 CFR Part 40.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
