7	An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8	2011, Section 14-103A, which relates to movement of manufactured homes; modifying allowable size and
9	width; requiring front and rear escort on certain roadways; allowing only daytime movement on certain
10	roadways; and providing an effective date.
11	
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 14-103A, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 14-103A. A. No combination of a motor vehicle and
16	manufactured home or frame or frames thereof shall have an overall
17	length, inclusive of front and rear bumpers, in excess of seventy
18	(70) feet or a width in excess of sixteen (16) <u>eighteen (18)</u> feet
19	while operating on the system of interstate and defense highways.
20	In determining the width of a manufactured home, the topside overall
21	width may shall not exceed the sixteen-foot eighteen-foot width
22	limit by no more than twelve (12) inches on each side for awnings,
23	doorknobs, or other fixtures extending beyond the body of the unit.
24	Such combination exceeding seventy (70) feet in length or eight and

1	one-half (8 $1/2$) feet in width must comply with the provisions of
2	Section 14-118 of this title. <u>A front and rear escort shall be</u>
3	required on the interstate and defense highways for vehicles meeting
4	the parameters of this subsection.
5	B. If any combination of a motor vehicle and manufactured home
6	or frame thereof $_{m{ au}}$ exceeds seventy (70) feet in overall length $_{m{ au}}$ or
7	eight and one-half (8 1/2) feet in width, they shall be moved only
8	during daylight hours <u>on the system of interstate and defense</u>
9	highways. The towing vehicle must be at least three-fourths (3/4)
10	ton three-fourths-ton rated capacity with dual wheels.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
