13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:										
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 82, O.S.L. 2016										
15	(40 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 405.1), is amended to read as follows:										
16	Section 405.1 A . There is hereby created in the State Treasury										
17	a revolving fund for the Department of Labor to be designated the										
18	"Department of Labor Administrative Penalty Revolving Fund". The										
19	fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year										
20	limitations, and shall consist of all administrative fines collected										
21	by the Department for violations of the Oklahoma Occupational Health										
22	and Safety Standards Act and the Oklahoma Asbestos Control Act, and										
23	any rules promulgated thereto. All monies accruing to the credit of										
24	the fund, except those monies specified in subsection B of this										

1	section, are hereby directed to be transferred by the Commissioner
2	of Labor to the State Treasurer for deposit and credit to the
3	General Revenue Fund at the end of each fiscal year.
4	B. The Department of Labor shall retain up to Thirty Thousand
5	Dollars (\$30,000.00) of monies accruing to the credit of the
6	Department of Labor Administrative Penalty Revolving Fund, derived
7	from citations for violations of the Oklahoma Occupational Health
8	and Safety Standards Act, per fiscal year. Said monies shall only
9	be used in support of this act for the production and dissemination
10	of workplace safety educational materials, for workplace safety
11	educational presentations and training, or for the acquisition of
12	workplace safety equipment, to be provided by the Department of
13	Labor, at its discretion, to employers as defined in Section 402 of
14	this title. Said monies shall not be expended for Department of
15	Labor employee salaries or benefits or for Department of Labor
16	administrative costs.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
