 - 8. Section 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2 or 1029 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved child prostitution;
 - 9. Section 1040.8 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved child pornography; or

Section 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 21 1114 or 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, 22 the court shall issue, unless otherwise requested by the victim of 23 the crime for which the defendant has been sentenced or has received 24 a deferred sentence, an order that the defendant shall have no
