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7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
8 2011, Section 2254, as amended by Section 996,
Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section
9 2254), which relates to the State Park System
Improvement Revolving Fund; modifying authorized
10 purposes for fund expenditures; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 2254, as
15 amended by Section 996, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.
16 2018, Section 2254), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 2254. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
18 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to
19 be designated the "State Park System Improvement Revolving Fund".
20 The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal year
21 limitations. The fund shall consist of all monies that are received
22 by the Department, from all entrance or day-use charges for the
23 state park system, including charges for an annual pass for visitors
24 to the state parks. All monies accruing to the fund are hereby

1 appropriated and may be expended by the Department ~~for the exclusive~~
2 ~~purpose of capital improvements~~ at the state park where the charges
3 were collected as authorized by Section 2220 of Title 74 of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
5 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
6 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
7 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
