8 An Act relating to the Office of Management and
9 Enterprise Services; providing for reappropriation
10 and redesignation of certain funds in certain amount
11 for a certain purpose; authorizing certain
12 expenditures of certain funds; providing amounts;
13 providing purposes; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION AND REDESIGNATION The amount
16 of Two Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00) of the
17 original appropriation of Five Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
18 (\$5,600,000.00), appropriated to the Office of Management and
19 Enterprise Services by Section 132, Chapter 146, O.S.L. 2018, from
20 any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of
21 the State Treasury to reconcile costs associated with the funding of
22 state pension systems, is hereby reappropriated and redesignated to
23 the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to perform duties
24 imposed upon the Office by law. If, on the date this act is

1 approved, any of the amount originally appropriated, as adjusted by
2 expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered
3 balance less than the reappropriated and redesignated amount, that
4 reappropriated and redesignated amount is reduced to the
5 unencumbered amount.

6 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
7 Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to
8 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Postal
9 Service Revolving Fund (Fund 231), the sum of One Hundred Fifty
10 Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of
12 Management and Enterprise Services by law.

13 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
14 Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to
15 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the
16 Registration of State Vendors Revolving Fund (Fund 270), the sum of
17 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
18 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of
19 Management and Enterprise Services by law.

20 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
21 Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to
22 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Vendor
23 Fees and Rebates Revolving Fund (Fund 271), the sum of One Million
24 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00) or so much

1 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
2 Office of Management and Enterprise Services by law.

3 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
