16 An Act relating to holidays; designating the second
17 week of October of each year as Veterans Suicide
18 Awareness Week; providing for codification; and
19 declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.24 of Title 25, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The second week of October of each year is hereby established as
2 "Veterans Suicide Awareness Week" in Oklahoma. All citizens of this
3 state are requested to devote some portion of Veterans Suicide
4 Awareness Week to commemorate those veterans lost to suicide and
5 bring awareness to veteran suicides.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
