AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 143, O.S.L. 14 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 322), is amended to read as 15 follows: 16 Section 322. A. There is hereby created the Office of Mobility 17 and Public Transit within the Department of Transportation. All 18 current Transit Division responsibilities, including oversight and 19 management of Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grants and 20 resources and the State Management Plan, are moved to the Office of 21 Mobility and Public Transit. Notwithstanding this subsection, the 22 Office of Mobility and Public Transit will not be responsible for 23 oversight and management of FTA grants and resources received by 24 transit agencies as a direct recipient of the FTA as that is not a

- 1 | current responsibility of the Transit Division. All Federal Transit
- 2 Administration program implementations not currently managed by the
- 3 Department of Transportation shall be moved to the Office of
- 4 | Mobility and Public Transit from other state agencies and other
- 5 | state programs. The Office of Mobility and Public Transit is
- 6 charged with overseeing a network of public transit systems that
- 7 | receive adequate funding to ensure the mobility needs of all

The plan 2 will be developed jointly by the Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma Transit Association. 3 4 A copy of the plan shall be submitted to the Governor, 5 the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate by July 1, 2020 6 7 December 1, 2020. b.
