6 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
7 providing mandatory break periods for employees;
8 providing for codification; and providing an
9 effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.8 of Title 57, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The Department of Corrections shall provide employees of the
15 Department one fifteen-minute break within the first eight (8) hours
16 worked and one additional fifteen-minute break every two (2) hours
17 thereafter. A supervisor of the Department shall not have the
18 discretion to deny a reasonable break or rest period during the
19 workday or regular shift period of an employee.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
