Section 12, Chapter 313, O.S.L. AMENDATORY 22 2014 (11 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 56-102), is amended to read as 23 follows:

- B. As used in the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act:
- "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the election of a specific candidate to municipal office, whose name as it will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the committee;
- "Municipal office" means any elective municipal office for which Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the secretary of the county election board as required by Sections 16-109 and 16-110 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title; and
- "Municipal political committee" means any committee composed of one two or more persons whose purpose includes the election or defeat of one or more candidates for municipal office, or questions submitted to a vote of the people at a municipal election, but which is not required to register with the Ethics Commission or the Federal Election Commission.

    Act. The statement of organization shall be accompanied by a check
