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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 1181, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1181. Any officer not subject to impeachment elected or  
16 appointed to any state, county, township, city, town, or other  
17 office under the laws of the state may, in the manner provided in  
18 this article, be removed from office for any of the following  
19 causes:

20 First. Habitual or willful neglect of duty.

21 Second. Gross partiality in office.

22 Third. Oppression in office.

23 Fourth. Corruption in office.

24 Fifth. Extortion or willful overcharge of fees in office.

1 Sixth. Willful maladministration.

2 Seventh. Habitual drunkenness.

3 Eighth. Failure to produce and account for all public funds and  
4 property in his or her hands, at any settlement or inspection  
5 authorized or required by law.

6 Ninth. Habitual absence from minimum required training events.

7 Tenth. Dereliction of duty.

8 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 1181.2, is  
9 amended to read as follows:

10 Section 1181.2 The complaint, petition, accusation or  
11 proceeding for removal or ouster from office in accordance with the  
12 procedures set forth in Section 18 of Article II of the Oklahoma  
13 Constitution, Section 101 of Title 38 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or  
14 Section 94 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes may include  
15 allegations or charges of any act or acts of commission, omission or  
16 neglect which may be committed, done or omitted during the term of  
17 office in which such ~~ouster or removal~~ proceeding may be filed, and  
18 may also include allegations or charges as to any act or acts of  
19 commission, omission or neglect committed, done or omitted during a  
20 previous or preceding term in such office.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
