NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is 17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall 19 display the national motto of the United States in a prominently 20 visible location in all state buildings. The placement and size of 21 the display shall be in keeping with the placement and size of the 22

display of the national motto in the United States Capitol Visitor

Center. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall be

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1	directly responsible for the provisions of this act, including any
2	related expenses.
3	B. In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the
4	display is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney
5	General is hereby authorized to prepare and present a legal defense
6	of the display.
7	C. The display of the national motto shall not be construed to
8	mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or
9	denomination thereof over others.
