8 State Government Transparency in Billing Act;
9 exempting Legislature and Judiciary from fees and
10 costs for services rendered by state agencies;
11 defining term; providing for codification; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 464.1 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "State
18 Government Transparency in Billing Act".

19 B. Except as otherwise provided by law, the legislative and
20 judicial branches of state government shall be exempt from any and
21 all fees and costs for services rendered by any appropriated state
22 agencies. For purposes of this section, "state agencies" means any
23 office, department, board, commission or institution of the
24 executive branch of state government.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
