1 transportation infrastructure and necessary transportation redundancy for the United States military installations at Tinker Air Force Base in Midwest City, OK, Fort Sill Army Base in Lawton, 3 4 OK, and the McAlester Army Ammunition Plant near McAlester, OK; and 5 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature is supportive of all tribal entities in the State of Oklahoma and furthermore the Oklahoma 7 Legislature understands that expanded rail service from central 8 Oklahoma to southeastern Oklahoma will economically benefit any and all tribal entities through which the expanded rail service runs; 10 and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature recognizes the role the Oklahoma Department of Transportation plays in ensuring that expanded rail service is an integral part of Oklahoma's economic future.
