By deleting the phrase "any illness or injury" and inserting in lieu thereof the following language: "epilepsy, seizures or momentary lapse of consciousness";

On page 2, section 2, line 19 by restoring the stricken language;

On page 2, section 2, lines 19 and 20 by deleting the following language: "shall inform the Department of the diagnosis by submitting";

On page 2, section 2, lines 20 and 21 by restoring the stricken language;

On page 2, section 2, line 21 by deleting the following language: "notification to the Department";

On page 2, section 2, line 22 by adding after the period "." the following language: "Any person who is diagnosed with epilepsy, seizures or momentary loss of consciousness that would impair the ability of the individual in any manner as to affect the performance of the person to operate a motor vehicle shall report their diagnosis, within one (1) week, to the Department or be charged with a misdemeanor for failure to report."

On page 3, section 2, lines 10-12 by deleting the following language: "However, a physician that intentionally violates the provisions of this section shall be charged with a misdemeanor."
