1 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as  
2 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.  
3 2019, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
6 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as  
7 provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
12 registered for the current year.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
14 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
15 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
16 Personalized license plates shall be scheduled to be renewed on the  
17 same month as any regular license plate that may belong to the same  
18 vehicle. The notice shall contain all necessary information and  
19 shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon  
20 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The  
21 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system except for  
22 legislative plates and amateur radio operator license plates.

23 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
24 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept

1 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
2 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
3 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
4 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
5 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
6 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
7 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
8 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
9 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

11 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
12 follows:

13 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
15 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war  
16 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification  
17 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war  
18 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having  
19 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving  
20 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not  
21 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war  
23 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
24 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special

1 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
2 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
3 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

4 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
5 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National  
6 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
7 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
8 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
10 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National  
11 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
12 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
13 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

14 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates  
15 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of  
16 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of  
17 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air  
18 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to  
19 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have  
20 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.  
21 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present  
22 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services  
23 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form  
24 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates

1 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but  
2 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such  
4 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been  
5 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply  
6 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each  
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
8 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

9 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are  
11 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse  
12 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is  
13 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the  
14 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon  
15 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action  
16 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse  
17 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each  
18 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in  
19 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
20 of one (1) ton or less;

21 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper  
23 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs  
24 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such

1 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.  
2 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate  
3 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
4 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been  
5 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not  
6 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated  
7 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one  
8 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
9 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee  
10 provided by this section for special license plates;

11 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
12 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
13 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
14 the United States as being:

- 15 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December  
16 7, 1941,  
17 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of  
18 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,  
19 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to  
20 exceed three (3) miles, and  
21 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
22 States Armed Forces.

1       Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate  
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
3 less;

4       9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States  
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United  
7 States as being:

- 8           a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February  
9               of 1945,
- 10          b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate  
11               vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12          c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
13               States Armed Forces.

14       Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each  
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16       Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall  
17 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and  
18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the  
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."  
20 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such  
21 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other  
22 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the  
23 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of  
24 registration after the initial issue;

1        10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
4 the United States as being:

5            a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,  
6                1944,

7            b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of  
8                Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such  
9                participation cannot be verified by the United States  
10               Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
11               the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its  
12               discretion, accept evidence of such participation from  
13               the person applying for the license plate, and

14           c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
15               States Armed Forces.

16        Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for  
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18        11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
20 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse  
21 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action  
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person  
24 was killed in action and that the person making the application is



1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse  
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two  
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)  
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
5 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be  
9 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
10 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply  
11 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification  
12 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making  
13 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent  
14 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two  
15 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one  
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be  
21 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the  
22 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the  
23 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or  
24 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a

1 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
5 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such  
6 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each  
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be  
9 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal  
10 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police  
11 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and  
12 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council  
13 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may  
14 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated  
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of  
16 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common  
17 education police department by either an identification card or  
18 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma  
19 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for  
20 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial  
21 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of  
22 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in  
23 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;  
24 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design

1 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in  
2 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

3 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from  
9 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may  
10 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a  
11 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall  
13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,  
16 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which  
17 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate  
18 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at  
19 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.  
20 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words  
21 "WORLD WAR II";

22 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June  
4 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former  
5 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for  
6 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall  
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
11 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member  
12 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the  
13 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two  
14 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the  
15 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

16 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and  
18 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or  
19 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only  
20 be produced upon application;

21 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are  
23 residents of this state. Such persons must present an  
24 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a

1 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with  
2 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend  
3 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the  
4 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and  
5 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the  
6 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red  
7 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design  
8 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other  
9 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each  
10 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

11 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
12 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the  
13 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and  
14 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert  
15 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
16 of one (1) ton or less;

17 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of  
19 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may  
20 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle  
21 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates  
23 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor  
24

1 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in  
2 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

3 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air  
5 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate  
6 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
7 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license  
8 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

9 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
10 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for  
11 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-  
12 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
13 the Ninety-Nines;

14 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall  
15 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.  
16 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend  
17 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the  
18 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".  
19 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate  
20 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
21 less;

22 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall  
23 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member  
24 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United

1 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat  
2 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

4 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be  
5 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of  
6 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for  
7 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall  
8 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

9 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such  
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
11 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the  
12 United States Secretary of Defense;

13 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
15 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any  
16 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as  
17 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such  
18 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
21 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate  
22 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the  
23 district number;

31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees



1 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this  
2 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

3 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate  
4 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the  
5 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be  
6 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also  
7 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized  
8 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled  
9 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the  
10 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to  
11 the Tax Commission;

12 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such  
13 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force  
14 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show  
15 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be  
16 designed in consultation with the Association;

17 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such  
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
19 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons  
20 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for  
21 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
22 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the  
23 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the  
24 Academy;

1        34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall  
2 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's  
3 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal  
4 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor  
5 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been  
6 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.  
7 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle  
8 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such  
9 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax  
10 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have  
11 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call  
12 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications  
13 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All  
14 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on  
15 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for  
16 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee  
17 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other  
18 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant  
19 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license  
20 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio  
21 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall  
22 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any  
23 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The  
24 right to such special identification plates herein provided for

1 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the  
2 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

3 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for  
5 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license  
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of  
7 Oklahoma;

8 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be  
9 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or  
10 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for  
11 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or  
12 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county  
13 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the  
14 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which  
15 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.  
16 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
17 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
18 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be  
19 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this  
20 state;

21 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates  
22 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of  
23 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"  
24 shall mean:

- 1           a.   any person honorably discharged from any branch of the  
2               United States Armed Forces or as a member of the  
3               Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result  
4               of the performance of duties for any branch of the  
5               United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard  
6               while on active military duty, or
- 7           b.   any person honorably discharged from any branch of the  
8               United States Armed Forces or as a member of the  
9               Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of  
10              injury, illness or disease caused by the performance  
11              of such duties while on active duty, whether the death  
12              occurred while on active duty or after the honorable  
13              discharge of such person.

14           The fee provided by this section for the special license plate  
15   authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other  
16   registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees  
17   levied by Section 1132 of this title;

18           38.   Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates  
19   shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has  
20   been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States  
21   Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense  
22   Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
23   capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1        39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.  
3 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide  
4 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The  
5 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th  
6 Infantry;

7        40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such  
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or  
9 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in  
10 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation  
11 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;  
13 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design  
14 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in  
15 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

16        41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -  
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this  
18 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.  
19 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus  
20 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
21 (1) ton or less;

22        42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such  
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or  
24 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in

1 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The  
2 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military  
3 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an  
4 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle  
5 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a  
6 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of  
7 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a  
8 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle  
9 license plate;

10 43. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall  
11 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member  
12 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one  
13 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this  
14 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system  
15 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included  
16 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a  
17 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a  
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 44. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such  
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or  
21 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a  
22 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate  
23 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute  
24 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.

1 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary  
2 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
3 (1) ton or less;

4 45. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such  
5 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting  
6 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans  
7 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that  
8 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military  
9 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient  
10 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one  
11 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

13 46. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
14 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or  
15 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such  
16 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership  
17 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license  
18 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

19 47. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
20 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or  
21 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such  
22 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership  
23 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license  
24 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

1        48. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates  
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon  
3 who present proper certification from the United States Department  
4 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action  
5 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat  
6 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated  
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8        49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates  
9 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United  
10 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense  
11 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such  
12 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate  
13 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
14 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to  
15 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

16        50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License  
17 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably  
18 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or  
19 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States  
20 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles  
21 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
22 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military  
23 Department of the State of Oklahoma;



1        51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who  
3 present proper certification from the United States Army. The  
4 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the  
5 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge  
6 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying  
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the  
8 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the  
9 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to  
10 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

11       52. Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be  
12 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of  
13 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi  
14 Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license  
15 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton  
16 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for  
17 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor  
18 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements  
19 for a motorcycle license plate;

20       53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates  
21 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present  
22 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation  
23 Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat  
24 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the  
2 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the  
3 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to  
4 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; and

5 54. Special Forces Association - such plates shall be designed  
6 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the Army  
7 Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear upon the person's  
8 United States military uniform the Army Special Forces Tab. Persons  
9 applying for the Special Forces Association license plate must  
10 provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special Forces Tab or  
11 authorizing its wear upon a United States military uniform. The  
12 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Special  
13 Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. The Tax Commission shall produce  
14 up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces Association  
15 license plate. Qualified persons may select one design at the time  
16 of application. The plates shall be issued to any qualified person  
17 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
18 seven, as for personalized license plates.

19 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such  
20 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to  
21 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License  
22 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma  
23 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration  
24 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

1       SECTION 2.       AMENDATORY       47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as  
2 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.  
3 2019, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

4       Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or  
7 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other  
8 subject as provided by this section.

9       Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
13 registered for the current year.

14       Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
15 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax  
16 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.  
17 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special  
18 license plates. Personalized license plates shall be scheduled to  
19 be renewed on the same month as any regular license plate that may  
20 belong to the same vehicle. The notice shall contain all necessary  
21 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure  
22 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.  
23 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

1       The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13       If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
14 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
15 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
16 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
17 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
18 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
19 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
20 removed from the vehicle.

21       Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates  
22 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall  
23 be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission  
24 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The

1 prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within  
2 one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the  
3 authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In  
4 the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by  
5 the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so  
6 received shall be refunded accordingly.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
8 follows:

9 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be  
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
11 round and square dancing;

12 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People  
13 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the

15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

19 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle  
20 Association;

21 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
23 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a  
24 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic  
2 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for  
3 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the  
4 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in  
5 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall  
6 contain the Masonic emblem;

7 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License  
8 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for  
9 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be  
10 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's  
11 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall  
13 contain the Shriner's emblem;

14 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air  
16 ballooning in this state;

17 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall  
18 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member  
19 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an  
20 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a  
21 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an  
22 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an  
23 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate  
24 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star  
2 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

3 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
5 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of  
6 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus  
8 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights  
9 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the  
10 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
11 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of  
12 Columbus emblem;

13 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and  
14 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license  
15 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license  
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

17 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be  
18 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons  
19 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in  
20 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in  
21 consultation with Kiwanis International;

22 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates  
23 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a  
24 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified

1 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a  
3 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed  
4 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public  
5 Accountants;

6 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
8 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons  
9 applying for such license plate must show proof of official  
10 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,  
11 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or  
12 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state  
13 emergency management department head;

14 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates  
15 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
16 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and  
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian  
18 Conservation Corps;

19 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and  
20 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian  
21 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license  
22 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton  
23 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the  
24 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate



1 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license  
2 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian  
3 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

4 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such  
5 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
6 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and  
7 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the  
8 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

9 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be  
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
11 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued  
12 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
13 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate  
14 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

15 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be  
16 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,  
17 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this  
18 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons  
19 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon  
20 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.  
21 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
22 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for

1        18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such  
2 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business

7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate

21 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person

3 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and  
5 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license  
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department  
7 of Health;

8 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such  
9 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
10 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.  
11 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central  
12 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

13 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated  
14 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons  
15 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community  
16 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be  
17 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of

19 31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be  
20 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma

1 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma  
2 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,  
3 2013;

4 37. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be  
5 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
6 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates  
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the  
8 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

9 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates  
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
11 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.  
12 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of  
13 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

14 39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates  
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
16 support for the United States Air Force Academy;

17 40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be  
18 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be  
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

20 41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall  
21 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
22 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be  
23 designed in consultation with representatives of the National  
24 Weather Center Directors;

1        42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
3 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in  
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish  
5 Foundation;

6        43. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.  
9 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South

11 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions  
12 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School  
13 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

14        49.    Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be  
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
16 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be  
17 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High  
18 School Alumni Association;

19        50.    Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such  
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
21 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
22 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
23 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
24 Association;



1        51. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be  
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle  
5 Association;

6        52. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be  
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
8 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in  
9 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization;

10       53. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates shall  
11 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness  
12 of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in  
13 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
16 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any  
17 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a  
18 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license  
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of  
20 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of  
21 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License  
22 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

23       55. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be  
24 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem

1 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden  
2 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

4 56. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall  
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
6 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.  
7 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the  
8 Arts;

9 57. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be  
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
11 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The  
13 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
14 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

15 58. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be  
16 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
17 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in  
18 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

19 59. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
20 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
21 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
22 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

23 60. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
24 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

1 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
2 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

3 61. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
5 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in  
6 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

7 62. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall  
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
9 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be  
10 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School  
11 District;

12 63. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such  
13 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
14 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in  
15 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National  
16 Alumni Association;

17 64. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates  
18 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and  
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current  
20 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation  
21 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

22 65. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates  
23 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and  
24 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original

Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

66. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the Tulsa 66ers Organization;

67. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick School District and shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Frederick School District;

68. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

69. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Fosters Initiative;

1        70. Red Dirt Jeeps License Plate - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
3 Red Dirt Jeeps and such plates shall be designed in consultation  
4 with Red Dirt Jeeps, L.L.C.;

5        71. Sons of the American Revolution License Plate - such plates  
6 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the  
7 Sons of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle in any  
8 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
9 as for personalized plates. Such plates shall be designed in  
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Society of the Sons of the American  
11 Revolution. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar  
12 design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space  
13 requirements of a motorcycle license plate;

14        72. Daughters of the American Revolution License Plate - such  
15 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
16 the Daughters of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle  
17 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
18 seven, as for personalized plates. Such plates shall be designed in  
19 consultation with the Oklahoma Society of the Daughters of the  
20 American Revolution. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of  
21 similar design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the  
22 space requirements of a motorcycle license plate;

23        73. Air Medal License Plate - such plates shall be designed and  
24 issued to Air Medal recipients. An individual requesting the plate

1 is required, at the time of application, to show proof he or she is  
2 a recipient of the Air Medal or sign an attestation stating that he  
3 or she is a medal recipient. The plates shall be designed to  
4 include the Air Medal emblem and shall include the words "Air Medal"  
5 on the plate;

6 74. Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy License Plate - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy.  
9 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
10 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
11 personalized license plates. The plates shall contain the official  
12 Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy logo;

13 75. The Pride of Oklahoma Marching Band License Plate - such  
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
15 demonstrate support for the Pride of Oklahoma marching band. The  
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the University of  
17 Oklahoma;

18 76. The Spirit of Oklahoma State Marching Band License Plate -  
19 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
20 demonstrate support for the Spirit of Oklahoma State marching band.  
21 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahoma State  
22 University;

23 77. Southeast Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be  
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

1 Southeast High School Spartans and such plates shall be designed in  
2 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association;

3 78. Catoosa High School License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
5 Catoosa High School located in Catoosa. The plates shall bear the  
6 image of the Catoosa High School mascot and be designed in  
7 consultation with representatives of Catoosa High School;

8 79. Toastmasters International License Plate - such plates  
9 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
10 Toastmasters International and shall be designed in consultation  
11 with District 16 of Toastmasters International;

12 80. Millwood High School Alumni License Plate - such plates  
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
14 support for Millwood High School Alumni. The license plate shall be  
15 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood High  
16 School Alumni Association;

17 81. Patriot Guard Riders License Plate - such plates shall be  
18 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for Patriot Guard  
19 Riders and shall be designed in consultation with the Patriot Guard  
20 Riders of Oklahoma; and

21 82. Bixby School District License Plate - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
23 the Bixby School District. The license plate shall be designed in  
24 consultation with representatives of the Bixby School District.

1 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)  
2 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other  
3 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
4 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the  
5 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year  
6 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in  
7 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the  
8 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act  
9 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the  
10 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in  
11 Section 1104 of this title."

12 "SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as  
13 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.  
14 2019, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
16 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
17 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide  
18 financial assistance as provided by this section.

19 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
20 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
21 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
22 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
23 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

24



1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
2 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax  
3 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.  
4 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special  
5 license plates. Personalized license plates shall be scheduled to  
6 be renewed on the same month as any regular license plate that may  
7 belong to the same vehicle. The notice shall contain all necessary  
8 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure  
9 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.  
10 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

11 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
13 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
14 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
15 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
16 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
18 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
19 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
20 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
21 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

23 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
24 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,

1 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
2 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
3 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
4 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
5 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
6 removed from the vehicle.

7 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,  
8 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax  
9 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid  
10 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by  
11 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the  
12 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall  
13 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are  
14 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
15 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

16 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
17 follows:

18 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates  
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
20 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As  
21 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
22 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

23 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be  
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide general public environmental education program created pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may

1 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated  
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon  
3 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire  
4 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief  
5 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
8 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &  
9 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and  
10 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

11 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be  
12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
13 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in  
14 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
15 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in  
16 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in  
17 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may  
18 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license  
19 plates.

20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
21 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of  
22 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be  
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State  
2 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child  
3 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
4 the prevention of child abuse.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
6 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -  
8 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
9 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The  
10 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers  
11 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized  
12 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States  
13 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if  
14 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United  
15 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be  
16 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or  
17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not  
18 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate  
19 issued;

20 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be  
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in  
22 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
23 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society  
24 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

1       8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

2           a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic  
3           Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As  
4           provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
5           collected for each vehicle license plate shall be  
6           apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society  
7           Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66  
8           Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

9           b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation  
10          with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The  
11          Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter  
12          into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66  
13          Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be  
14          required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66  
15          Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing  
16          agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma  
17          Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty  
18          Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate  
19          issued;

20       9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be  
21       designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of  
22       the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal  
23       Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided  
24       in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited

1 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in  
2 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates  
4 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency  
5 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical  
6 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical  
8 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in  
9 consultation with the state association of emergency medical  
10 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
11 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel  
12 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63  
13 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be  
15 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of  
16 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount  
17 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act  
18 Revolving Fund;

19 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall  
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
21 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates  
22 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims  
23 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
24 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for

1 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use  
2 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to  
3 provide services to crime victims;

4 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates  
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
6 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The  
7 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
8 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of  
9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -  
10 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to  
11 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

12 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,  
13 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the  
14 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
15 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued  
16 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in  
17 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to  
18 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in  
19 Section 1104.4 of this title;

20 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be  
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,  
22 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in  
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
24 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the



1 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount  
2 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section  
3 1104.3 of this title;

4 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates  
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
6 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The  
7 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
8 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As  
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
11 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
12 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be  
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
15 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the  
16 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to  
17 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license  
18 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate  
19 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three  
20 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as  
21 follows:

- 22 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education  
23 Reform Revolving Fund,  
24

- 1           b.     five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher  
2                 Education Revolving Fund,  
3           c.     five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State  
4                 Career Technology Fund, and  
5           d.     eighty-five percent (85%) ~~of the fee~~ shall be

16          the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the  
17          legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the  
18          Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as  
19          used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate  
20          shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in  
21          combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or  
22          emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.  
23          Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of

13 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax  
14 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
15 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing  
16 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America  
17 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment  
18 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars  
19 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such  
21 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
22 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
23 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state  
24 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and

1 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
2 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of  
3 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5  
4 of this title;

5 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates  
6 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
7 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and  
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
9 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee  
10 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
11 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and  
12 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

13 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall  
14 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant  
15 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and  
16 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and  
17 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of  
18 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be  
19 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the  
20 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.  
21 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited  
22 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be  
23 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of

19 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions  
20 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
22 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be  
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation  
24 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association

1 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter  
2 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service  
3 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
4 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars  
5 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

6 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be  
7 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
8 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person  
9 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting  
10 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's  
11 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,  
12 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
13 Section 1104.8 of this title;

14 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter  
15 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any  
16 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the  
17 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person  
18 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
19 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain  
20 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The  
21 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
22 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of  
23 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use  
24 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The

1 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts  
2 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout

5 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates  
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

9 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing  
10 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing

9 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the

12 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in  
13 Section 1104.10 of this title;

14 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in

19 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
20 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion

23 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be  
24 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma



1 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma

3 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on  
4 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any  
5 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As

9 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and  
10 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license  
11 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected

14 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be  
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma

18 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma  
19 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this

21 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued  
22 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes  
23 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,  
24 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be

1 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.  
2 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
3 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and  
4 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

5 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates  
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
7 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be  
8 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from  
9 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official  
10 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark  
11 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax  
12 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with  
13 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be  
14 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or  
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
16 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for  
17 each license plate issued;

18 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall  
19 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
20 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor  
21 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from  
22 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26  
23 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to  
24 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military

1 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any

1 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma  
2 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any

8 provided in Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars  
10 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other  
11 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
12 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

13 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other  
14 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as  
15 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph  
16 authorizing the special license plate;

17 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall  
18 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be  
19 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
20 Registration Act; and

21 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as  
22 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

23 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.6, is  
24 amended to read as follows:

1       Section 1135.6   The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized  
2 to design and issue National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing  
3 Driver ("NASCAR") Theme License Plates.   Such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in  
5 NASCAR auto racing.   The plates shall be of such design as the  
6 supplier of the license plates in consultation with the Oklahoma Tax  
7 Commission may prescribe.   The fee for such plate shall be Forty  
8 Dollars (\$40.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration  
9 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.  
10 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing  
11 agreement with the supplier of such NASCAR Driver license plates or  
12 other entity for any required licensing fees.   The licensing  
13 agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than Twenty-five  
14 Percent (25%) of the fee authorized for each license plate issued.  
15 Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the forty-dollar fee shall be apportioned to  
16 the General Revenue Fund.   The remaining amount of such fee shall be  
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18       For license plates numbered zero (0) through one hundred (100)  
19 displaying a particular NASCAR Driver theme, the Oklahoma Tax  
20 Commission may establish an auction or similar procedure for the  
21 purpose of determining the order in which such distinctive license  
22 plates are sold and the amount of the additional fee for the  
23 distinctive license plates.   This amount shall be due at the time  
24 the original application is submitted to the Tax Commission and

1 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) thereafter annually at the time of renewal  
2 registration. NASCAR Driver license plates shall be scheduled to be  
3 renewed on the same month as any regular license plate that may  
4 belong to the same vehicle."
