1 "SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.7, as
2 amended by Section 1, Chapter 103, O.S.L. 2015 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019,
3 Section 130.7), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 130.7 A. Each county commissioner, county clerk,
5 county treasurer, and court clerk ~~holding office on May 11, 1982~~
6 elected or appointed after November 1, 2020, and those elected
7 ~~thereafter and the deputies of such elected county officers~~ shall be
8 ~~required to participate in the appropriate training programs, as~~
9 ~~defined in subsection B of this section, and educational seminars~~
10 ~~relevant to their positions and duties conducted pursuant to~~
11 ~~Sections 130.1 through 130.7 of this title. In addition, county~~
12 ~~sheriffs and county assessors may attend the training programs~~
13 specified in this section, within ninety (90) days after the general
14 election of his or her first term of office, to attend and complete
15 the orientation training provided through or approved by the County
16 Training Program of the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma
17 State University.

18 B. ~~Appropriate training programs shall include those programs~~
19 ~~provided by the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State~~
20 ~~University~~ 1. Each county commissioner, county clerk and county
21 treasurer elected or appointed after November 1, 2020, shall be
22 required to obtain a Basic Certification by the end of his or her
23 first term, an Advanced I Certification by the end of his or her
24 second term, and an Advanced II Certification by the end of his or

1 her third term prescribed by and provided through the County
2 Training Program of the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma
3 State University.

4 2. County commissioners, county clerks and county treasurers
5 holding office on November 1, 2020, shall obtain:

6 a. Basic Certification by November 1, 2024, if still
7 holding the same office,

8 b. Advanced I Certification by November 1, 2028, if still
9 holding the same office, and

10 c. Advanced II certification by November 1, 2032, if
11 still holding the same office.

12 C. At the discretion of the County Training Program of the
13 Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State University, current,
14 approved training hours accumulated through previous terms shall
15 apply toward Basic, Advanced I and Advanced II certifications.

16 D. 1. Court clerks elected or appointed after November 1,
17 2020, shall complete the required hours to obtain their certificate
18 through the County Training Program of the Cooperative Extension
19 Service at Oklahoma State University by the end of their first
20 terms. County assessors and county sheriffs elected or appointed
21 after November 1, 2020, shall obtain their certificate through the
22 County Training Program of the Cooperative Extension Service at
23 Oklahoma State University by the end of their second terms. By
24 discretion of the County Training Program of the Cooperative

1 Extension Service at Oklahoma State University, current, approved
2 training hours accumulated through previous terms shall apply toward
3 certificate hours.

4 2. Court clerks holding office November 1, 2020, shall complete
5 the required hours to obtain their certificate through the County
6 Training Program of the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma
7 State University by November 1, 2024, if still holding the same
8 office. County assessors and county sheriffs holding office on
9 November 1, 2020, shall obtain their certificate through the County
10 Training Program of the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma
11 State University by November 1, 2028, if still holding the same
12 office. By discretion of the County Training Program of the
13 Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State University, current,
14 approved training hours accumulated through previous terms shall
15 apply toward certificate hours.

16 E. Upon completion of the requirements in subsections A through
17 D of this section, each county commissioner, county clerk, county
18 treasurer and county court clerk shall be required to attend six (6)
19 hours of continuing education per calendar year through or approved
20 by the County Training Program of the Cooperative Extension Service
21 at Oklahoma State University.

1 F. The deputies of each elected county officer shall
2 participate in the training and educational seminars relevant to
3 their positions and duties."
