On page 3, Section 1, line 1 by deleting the sentence "There is hereby established a Renewable Natural Gas Option."

On page 3, section 1, lines 2-3 by deleting the phrase "promulgate rules allowing" and inserting in lieu thereof the following language: ", no later than December 1, 2020, issue a report and recommendations to the legislature regarding the ability and appropriateness of";

On page 3, section 1, line 4 by inserting after first occurrence of the word "gas" and before the period "." the following language "to customers";

On page 3, section 1, lines 4-10 by deleting the language beginning with the word "The" on line 4 and ending with the word "state's" on line ten and inserting in lieu thereof the following language: "The report shall address a recommendation for the state's";

On page 3, section 1, line 10 after the word "standard" and before the word "to" by adding the following language: ", or goal,";

On page 3, section 1, lines 12-13 by deleting the following language "In addition, the rules shall provide for the" and inserting in lieu thereof
