1 "SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 441, O.S.L. 2 2019 (62 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 36), is amended to read as 3 follows: 4 Section 36. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 5 fund for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to be designated the "Digital Transformation Program Revolving Fund". 6 7 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of monies designated to the fund by 8 9 law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby 10 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of 11 Management and Enterprise Services for the sole purpose of 12 implementing digital transformation initiatives, and upon request of 13 the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, to pay for administrative 14 support expenses for the Rural Broadband Expansion Council as 15 provided by Section 3 of this act. Expenditures from the fund shall 16 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims 17 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of 18 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 19 Monthly the Director of the Office of Management and 20 Enterprise Services shall submit reports to the Speaker of the 21 Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the 22 Oklahoma State Senate, the Chair of the Appropriations and Budget 23 Committee of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Chair of 24 the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State Senate detailing:
