[teachers - requiring emergency-certified teachers
to complete professional development training prior
to teaching - codification - effective date]

~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-195.3 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A person who is issued an emergency certificate by the State
Board of Education pursuant to subsection F of Section 6-187 of
Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and who does not already hold a
standard certificate shall complete no less than one (1) day of
professional development training as provided in subsection C of
this section prior to entering the classroom if he or she is hired
before the school year begins. If a person who is issued an

1 emergency certificate by the State Board of Education pursuant to
2 subsection F of Section 6-187 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
3 is hired after the school year begins, a school district shall
4 provide six (6) hours of professional development training as
5 provided in subsection C of this section within two (2) weeks of
6 entering the classroom. A school district may also require a new
7 certified teacher to complete no less than one (1) day of
8 professional development training as provided in subsection C of
9 this section prior to entering the classroom.

10 B. The training shall be offered by the employing school
11 district. School districts may cooperate with other districts or
12 contract with an institution of higher education to offer the
13 training.

14 C. The training described in this section shall include, but
15 not be limited to, the following professional development:

- 16 1. Classroom management skills; and
- 17 2. School and classroom procedures and policies.

18 D. The school district shall provide additional training
19 opportunities for teachers with emergency certification throughout
20 the school year. Pursuant to Section 6-195 of Title 70 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes, the school principal shall also arrange a mentor
22 to provide support, guidance and advice to the emergency-certified
23 teacher on an ongoing basis. The mentor shall be in addition to any
24 instructional coach that may be provided by the district.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
