19	Section 481. A State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision		
20	hereinafter referred to as the "Board", is hereby re-created, to		
21	continue until July 1, $\frac{2019}{2024}$, in accordance with the provisions		
22	of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall be composed of seven		
23	(7) allopathic physicians licensed to practice medicine in this		
24	state and represent the public and $\frac{1}{1}$ four (4) lay members.
