15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 7 of Enrolled House Bill		
17	No. 1094 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, is		
18	amended to reads as follows:		
19	Section 7. It shall be punishable by an administrative fine not		
20	to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for any person, firm,		
21	association, corporation or trust to engage in business as, or serve		
22	in the capacity of, a new motor vehicle salesperson in this state		
23	without first obtaining a certificate of registration with the		
24	Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission. <u>However</u> , a holder of a		

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    certificate to sell new or unused motor vehicles may also sell used
    motor vehicles for the dealer at the motor vehicle dealer's licensed
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    franchise location; provided, such a person shall only be authorized
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    to sell used motor vehicles for the dealer at the motor vehicle
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    dealer's licensed franchise location and to represent the motor
    vehicle dealer at used motor vehicle auctions without obtaining a
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    separate used motor vehicle salesperson's certificate. The cost of
    registration for each new salesperson shall be set at Twenty-five

    Dollars ($25.00) to be renewed annually. The cost of registration
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    is to be borne by the employing entity of the new salesperson. The
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    Commission shall promulgate rules and procedures necessary for the
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    implementation and creation of the registry and the issuance of
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    certificates of registration.
        SECTION 1. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
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        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
