BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 7 of Enrolled House Bill
No. 1094 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, is
amended to reads as follows:

Section 7. It shall be punishable by an administrative fine not
to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for any person, firm,
association, corporation or trust to engage in business as, or serve
in the capacity of, a new motor vehicle salesperson in this state
without first obtaining a certificate of registration with the
Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission. However, a holder of a

1 certificate to sell new or unused motor vehicles may also sell used
2 motor vehicles for the dealer at the motor vehicle dealer's licensed
3 franchise location; provided, such a person shall only be authorized
4 to sell used motor vehicles for the dealer at the motor vehicle
5 dealer's licensed franchise location and to represent the motor
6 vehicle dealer at used motor vehicle auctions without obtaining a
7 separate used motor vehicle salesperson's certificate. The cost of
8 registration for each new salesperson shall be set at Twenty-five
9 Dollars (\$25.00) to be renewed annually. The cost of registration
10 is to be borne by the employing entity of the new salesperson. The
11 Commission shall promulgate rules and procedures necessary for the
12 implementation and creation of the registry and the issuance of
13 certificates of registration.

14 ~~SECTION 1. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.~~

15 ~~SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
16 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
17 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
18 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
