21	authorized employee of the Department of Public Safety, either a:
22	1. Registration certificate or an official copy thereof;

Registration certificate or an official copy thereof issued 2 for a replacement vehicle in the same registration period; Temporary receipt printed upon self-initiated electronic 3 renewal of a registration via the Internet; or 4 5 5. Cab card issued for a vehicle registered under the International Registration Plan. 6 7 The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not apply to the first thirty (30) days after purchase of a replacement vehicle. 10 C. Fine and court costs for violating the provision of 11 paragraph 1 of subsection A of this section shall not exceed Twenty 12 Dollars (\$20.00). 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. SECTION 3.
