[ Oklahoma Employment Security Commission -

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-902 of Title 40, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall be  
required to have a performance audit conducted by the Oklahoma State  
Auditor and Inspector not less than once every five (5) years to  
ensure the proper and efficient operation of the agency; provided,  
however, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Employment Security  
Commission is authorized to divide the required performance audit  
into annual incremental audits of programs, departments or divisions  
of the agency to expedite and complete a five-year audit plan.

1 B. The cost of each audit required in subsection A of this  
2 section shall be paid with funds from the Oklahoma Employment  
3 Security Commission Revolving Fund, subject to availability.

4 C. The Oklahoma State Auditor and Inspector shall provide a  
5 report of each audit to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the  
6 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 1  
7 after the audit is completed. Each audit and report shall comply  
8 with 20 C.F.R. Section 603.

9 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2011, Section 4-901, as  
10 amended by Section 133, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (40 O.S. Supp.  
11 2019, Section 4-901), is amended to read as follows:

12 Section 4-901. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a  
13 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, to  
14 be designated the "Oklahoma Employment Security Commission Revolving  
15 Fund". The revolving fund shall consist of all penalties and  
16 interest received by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission.  
17 ~~Said~~ The revolving fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to  
18 fiscal year limitations and shall not be subject to legislative  
19 appropriation. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the revolving fund shall be  
20 made pursuant to the laws of this state and the statutes relating to  
21 the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission and shall be for  
22 administration expenses of the Oklahoma Employment Security  
23 Commission, performance audit expenses and for any other purpose  
24 which the Legislature directs. Warrants for expenditures from ~~said~~

1 the fund shall be drawn by the State Treasurer, based on claims  
2 signed by an authorized employee or employees of the Oklahoma  
3 Employment Security Commission and approved for payment by the  
4 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
