- B. The task force shall be composed of the following seventeen (17) members:

 - 3. The Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs or designee;
- 4. The Executive Director of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training or designee;
 - 5. The State Fire Marshal or designee;
 - 6. The Director of the ABLE Commission or designee;
 - 7. The Cabinet Secretary of Public Safety or designee;
 - 8. The Chief of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol or designee;
- 9. The Attorney General or designee;
