FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

[public finance - Director of the Office of
Management and Enterprise Services - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 34.6, as
last amended by Section 1, Chapter 342, O.S.L. 2013 (62 O.S. Supp.
2018, Section 34.6), is amended to read as follows:

Section 34.6. A. The Director of the Office of Management and
Enterprise Services shall have the power and duty under the
direction of the Governor to:

1. Prepare the budget document and assist in the drafting of
legislation to make it effective;

2. Make field surveys and studies of governmental agencies,
looking toward economy and greater efficiency;

3. Make allotments to control expenditures;

4. Authorize transfers of appropriation authorized by law;

1 5. Study accounting and other reports rendered by the Central
2 Accounting and Reporting Division;

3 6. Enter into agreements with the United States Secretary of
4 the Treasury for the purpose of implementing federal law;

5 7. Aid the Governor in the economical management of state
6 affairs; ~~and~~

7 8. Conduct training that provides an overview of state finance
8 policies and procedures for state agency employees upon their
9 initial appointment to a position that includes performing state
10 finance and budget functions. Such employees shall complete the
11 training within six (6) months of assuming such position; and

12 9. Adopt such rules and regulations concerning the exercise of
13 powers and duties as the Director shall deem appropriate, in
14 accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.

15 B. In addition to other duties, the Director of the Office of
16 Management and Enterprise Services shall, upon request, advise and
17 consult with members of the Legislature and legislative committees
18 concerning revenue and expenditures of state agencies.

19 C. Not later than December 31, 2013, the Director of the Office
20 of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide the Legislature
21 with a proposal to consolidate, streamline, and reduce the size of
22 the administrative code of the agencies consolidated pursuant to
23 House Bill No. 2140 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma
24 Legislature. The recommendation shall contain the Director's advice

1 on the possibility of consolidating the affected code into a single
2 title.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
