FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

[state government - repealer - requests for
unclassified positions and employees - codification -
effective date.]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Section 841.30, as
amended by Section 922, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.
2018, Section 841.30), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-5.27 of Title 74, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. State agencies subject to the provisions of the Merit System
of Personnel Administration shall submit requests to the
subcommittee of the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State
Senate under whose jurisdiction the state agency resides for
authorizations to add unclassified positions and employees to the
state service that are in addition to unclassified positions already

1 authorized by law. The Legislature may approve or disapprove the
2 request by the proper passage of a concurrent resolution introduced
3 by the chair or vice-chair of the subcommittee.

4 B. State agencies subject to the provisions of the Merit System
5 of Personnel Administration shall submit requests to the
6 subcommittee of the Appropriations Committee of the Oklahoma State
7 Senate under whose jurisdiction the state agency resides for
8 authorizations for reclassification of current positions and
9 employees in the state service not already specified as classified
10 or unclassified by law. The Legislature may approve or disapprove
11 the request by the proper passage of a concurrent resolution
12 introduced by the chair or vice-chair of the subcommittee.

13 C. Except as otherwise provided by this section:

14 1. If the requests are received on or before April 1, the
15 Legislature shall have until the last day of the regular legislative
16 session of that year to review the requests; and

17 2. If the requests are received after April 1, the Legislature
18 shall have until the last day of the regular legislative session of
19 the next year to review the requests.

20 D. Unless otherwise authorized by the Legislature, whenever a
21 request is disapproved as provided in subsection A or B of this
22 section, the agency submitting the request shall not have authority
23 to resubmit an identical request, except during the first sixty (60)
24 calendar days of the next regular legislative session.

1 E. Unless otherwise provided by specific vote of the
2 Legislature, concurrent resolutions introduced for purposes of
3 approving or disapproving a request or the omnibus concurrent
4 resolution described in subsection F of this section shall not be
5 subject to regular legislative cutoff dates, shall be limited to
6 such provisions as may be necessary for disapproval or approval of a
7 request, and any such other direction or mandate regarding the
8 request deemed necessary by the Legislature. The resolution shall
9 contain no other provisions.

10 F. The Legislature may have an omnibus concurrent resolution
11 prepared for consideration each session. The concurrent resolution
12 shall be substantially in the following form: "All requests for
13 authorizations for adding unclassified positions and employees to
14 the state service that are in addition to unclassified positions
15 already authorized by law from Oklahoma state agencies filed on or
16 before April 1 are hereby approved except for the following:" or
17 "All requests for authorizations for reclassification of current
18 positions and employees in the state service not already specified
19 as classified or unclassified by law from Oklahoma state agencies
20 filed on or before April 1 are hereby approved except for the
21 following:". For the purpose of this section, a request may be
22 disapproved, in whole or in part, in the omnibus concurrent
23 resolution considered by the Legislature.

1 G. Upon proper passage of the concurrent resolution introduced
2 for purposes of approving a request pursuant to subsection A or B of
3 this section, the request shall be authorized to commence. No state
4 agency subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel
5 Administration shall add an unclassified position or employee to the
6 state service in addition to unclassified positions already
7 authorized by law unless it has been approved pursuant to this
8 section or other provision of law. No state agency subject to the
9 provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration shall
10 reclassify a current position or employee in the state service
11 unless it has been approved pursuant to this section or other
12 provision of law.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
