9 An Act relating to public health; requiring assisted
10 living centers to provide certain information to
11 residents; specifying information to be given;
12 providing that taking certain action shall be deemed
13 compliance; providing certain construction;
14 protecting assisted living centers from certain civil
15 and administrative actions; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.7a of Title 63, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Each assisted living center shall annually post in a
22 conspicuous location the current Vaccine Information Statements as
23 provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, no later
24 than September 1 of each year, with educational information on
 influenza disease. Such information shall include, but not be
 limited to:

1 1. The risks associated with influenza disease;

2 2. The availability, effectiveness and known contraindications
3 of the influenza immunization;

4 3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and

5 4. The means by which influenza is spread.

6 B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an
7 assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization
8 against influenza for its residents.

9 C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or
10 damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or
11 the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.

12 D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected
13 nor shall fines be imposed or deficiencies be cited due to the
14 providing, or lack of providing, the educational information
15 pursuant to this section.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
