10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by Section 12,
13 Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section
14 1135.2), which relates to specialty license plates;
15 deleting certain plate; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
16 Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 15,
17 Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section
18 1135.5), which relates to support and assistance
19 specialty license plates; creating the Oklahoma
20 Veterans of Foreign Wars Specialty License Plate;
21 providing for design; authorizing licensing
22 agreement; specifying fees; specifying apportionment
23 of fees; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
3 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
4 provided by this section.

5 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
6 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
7 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
8 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
9 registered for the current year.

10 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
11 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
12 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
13 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
14 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
15 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
16 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
17 amateur radio operator license plates.

18 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
19 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
20 applications for special license plates authorized under this
21 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
22 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
23 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
24 information directly into such system and generate a receipt

1 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
2 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
3 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
4 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
5 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

6 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
7 follows:

8 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
10 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
11 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
12 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
13 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
14 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
15 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
16 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
17 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
18 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
19 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

23 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National

1 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
2 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
3 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
6 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
7 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
8 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
10 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
11 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
12 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
13 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
14 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
15 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
16 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
17 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
18 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form
19 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
20 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
21 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

22 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
24 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply

1 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

4 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
6 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
7 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
8 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
9 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
10 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
11 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
12 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
13 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
14 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
15 of one (1) ton or less;

16 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
18 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
19 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
20 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
21 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
22 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
23 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
24 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not

1 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
2 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
3 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
4 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
5 provided by this section for special license plates;

6 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
8 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
9 the United States as being:

- 10 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
11 7, 1941,
12 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
13 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
14 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
15 exceed three (3) miles, and
16 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
17 States Armed Forces.

18 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
19 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less;

21 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
22 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
23 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
24 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February of 1945,
- b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6, 1944,

- 1 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
2 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
3 participation cannot be verified by the United States
4 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
5 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
6 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
7 the person applying for the license plate, and
8 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
9 States Armed Forces.

10 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
11 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
14 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
15 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
16 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
17 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
18 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
19 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
20 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
21 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
22 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
23 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
24

1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
5 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
6 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
7 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
8 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
9 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
10 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
11 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
12 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
13 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
14 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

15 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
17 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
18 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
19 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
20 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such

1 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
5 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
6 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
7 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
8 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
9 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
11 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
12 education police department by either an identification card or
13 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
14 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
15 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
16 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
17 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
19 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
20 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
21 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

22 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
4 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
5 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
6 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
11 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
12 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
13 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
14 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
15 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
16 "WORLD WAR II";

17 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
19 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
20 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
21 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
22 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
23 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
24

1 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
2 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
7 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
8 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
9 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
10 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
11 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

12 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
14 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
15 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
16 be produced upon application;

17 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
19 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
20 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
21 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
22 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
23 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
24 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and

1 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
2 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
3 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
4 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
5 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
6 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

7 ~~20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall~~
8 ~~be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any~~
9 ~~resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars~~
10 ~~organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of~~
11 ~~Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans~~
12 ~~of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed~~
13 ~~in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;~~

14 ~~21.~~ Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
16 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
17 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
18 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
19 of one (1) ton or less;

20 ~~22.~~ 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
22 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such
23 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each
24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1 ~~23.~~ 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License
2 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or
3 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
4 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

5 ~~24.~~ 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
7 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
8 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
9 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
10 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

11 ~~25.~~ 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons
13 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the
14 Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Ninety-Nines;

16 ~~26.~~ 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman
18 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the
19 legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers.
20 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat
21 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman
22 Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
23 of one (1) ton or less;

1 ~~27.~~ 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
3 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the
4 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia
5 Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 ~~28.~~ 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
9 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
10 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
11 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

12 ~~29.~~ 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
14 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
15 United States Secretary of Defense;

16 ~~30.~~ 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
18 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
19 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
20 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
21 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 ~~31.~~ 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall

1 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator
2 serves and the district number;

3 ~~32.~~ 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
5 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
6 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
7 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
8 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
9 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
10 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
11 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
12 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
13 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
14 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
15 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
17 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
18 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
19 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
20 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
21 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
23 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
24 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other

1 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
2 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
3 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

4 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
5 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
6 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
7 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
8 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
9 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
10 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
11 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
12 the Tax Commission;

13 ~~33.~~ 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates -
14 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air
15 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must
16 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

18 ~~34.~~ 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
20 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
21 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
22 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
23 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
24

Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the Academy;

~~35.~~ 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.

Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle identification plates as herein provided. Application for such identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee required in this section together with a certificate, or such other evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any

1 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
2 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
3 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
4 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

5 ~~36.~~ 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
7 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
9 Oklahoma;

10 ~~37.~~ 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
12 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
13 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
14 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
15 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
16 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
17 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
18 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
19 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
20 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
21 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
22 state;

23 ~~38.~~ 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of

1 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
2 shall mean:

- 3 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
4 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
5 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
6 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
7 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
8 while on active military duty, or
- 9 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
10 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
11 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
12 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
13 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
14 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
15 discharge of such person.

16 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
17 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
18 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
19 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 ~~39.~~ 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
22 who has been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United
23 States Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea
24

18 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
19 issued on a staggered system.

20 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
21 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
22 applications for special license plates authorized under this
23 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
24 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount

1 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
2 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
3 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
4 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
5 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
6 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

8 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
9 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
10 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
11 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
12 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
13 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
14 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
15 removed from the vehicle.

16 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
17 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
18 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
19 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
20 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
21 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
22 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
23 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
24 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as

22 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
23 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

1 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
3 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
4 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
5 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
6 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

18 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
19 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
20 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

21 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
23 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
24 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any

1 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
2 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
3 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
4 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
5 plates.

6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
7 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
8 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
12 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
13 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the prevention of child abuse.

15 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
16 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

18 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
20 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers

23 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if

20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
21 deposited in the Oklahoma ~~Capitol Complex and Centennial~~
22 ~~Commemoration Commission~~ Department of Commerce Revolving Fund
23 created in Section ~~98.5~~ 5012 of Title ~~73~~ 74 of the Oklahoma
24 Statutes;

1 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
4 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
6 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
7 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
8 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
9 follows:

- 10 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
11 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 12 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher

20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
22 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
23 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
24 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax

1 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
2 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
3 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
4 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
5 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
6 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
8 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
9 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
10 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
11 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
12 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
14 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
15 of this title;

16 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
20 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
22 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
23 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

1 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
2 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
3 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
4 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
5 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
6 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
7 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
8 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.

8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of

11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
13 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
14 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license

16 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

73. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
2 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
3 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
4 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
6 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
7 each license plate issued;

8 74. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
10 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
11 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
12 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
13 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
14 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
16 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
17 each license plate issued;

18 75. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
21 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
23 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
24 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four

1 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
2 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
3 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 76. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
7 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
8 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
9 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
10 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
11 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
12 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 77. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
14 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
15 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
16 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
17 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
20 Revolving Fund created in Section ~~5~~ 1104.29 of this ~~act~~ title;

21 78. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
24 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School

1 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
2 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
3 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
4 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
5 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
6 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; ~~and~~

7 79. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
10 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
11 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
12 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
13 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
14 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement
15 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
16 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
17 issued; and

18 80. Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and
20 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans
21 of Foreign Wars organization in this state. Such persons may apply
22 for Veterans of Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership
23 in a Veterans of Foreign Wars organization. Such plates shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars

1 organization. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
2 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Veterans of
3 Foreign Wars Foundation for any licensing fee which may be required
4 in order to use the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
6 Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more than
7 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each license plate issued.

8 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
9 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
10 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
11 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

12 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
13 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
14 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
15 license plate;

16 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
18 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

20 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
21 provided in Section 1104 of this title.
