



1 suspended sentence or any probationary term for a crime or an  
2 attempt to commit a crime provided for in:

3 1. Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
4 offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, as those terms  
5 are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma  
6 Statutes;

7 2. Section 681 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
8 offense involved sexual assault;

9 3. Section 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
10 offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation;

11 4. Section 748 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
12 offense involved human trafficking for commercial sex;

13 5. Section 843.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
14 offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation;

15 6. Section 852.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
16 offense involved sexual abuse of a child;

17 7. Section 866, 885, 886, 888 or 891 of Title 21 of the  
18 Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual  
19 exploitation;

20 8. Section 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2 or 1029 of Title 21 of  
21 the Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved child prostitution;

22 9. Section 1040.8 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the  
23 offense involved child pornography; or

1        10. Section 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a, 1087, 1088, 1111.1,  
2 1114 or 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,  
3 the court shall issue, unless otherwise requested by the victim of  
4 the crime for which the defendant has been sentenced or has received  
5 a deferred sentence, an order that the defendant shall have no  
6 contact directly or indirectly with the victim or the family of the  
7 victim during the full term of the confinement of the defendant,  
8 term of probation, period of deferment or term of confinement and  
9 probation of the defendant.

10        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
