Not less than thirty (30) days after release from custody of the Department of Corrections, has secured admission to and enrolled in an institution which is a member of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education or a career and technology education program and has provided proof of such admission and enrollment to the court.
 - B. Upon successful graduation or completion of training and course work required for certification, the court shall have the authority to waive or reduce all outstanding fines, court costs and fees owed by the person in every felony or misdemeanor case filed in a district court or criminal case filed in a municipal court of this state.
 - C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to amounts owed by the person for restitution to a victim pursuant to a court order or child support obligations pursuant to a court order.
