12 An Act relating to schools; declaring legislative
13 intent; defining terms; allowing instruction in early
14 childhood education to foster certain development and
15 learning; providing certain learning environment;
16 authorizing educators to provide certain learning
17 opportunities; authorizing certain professional
18 development for teachers; providing for codification;
19 and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.2a of Title 70, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. It is the intention of the Oklahoma State Legislature
 through this act to focus on the importance of child-centered, play-

1 based learning as the most rigorous and most developmentally
2 appropriate way for children in the early childhood grade levels to
3 learn literacy, science, technology, engineering, art and math
4 academic concepts.

5 B. As used in this section:

6 1. "Child-directed" means interaction in which the child is
7 helped to direct and lead the play in any way the child wishes,
8 unless there is harmful or destructive activity;

9 2. "Domains" means a specified sphere of activity or knowledge;

10 3. "Early childhood education" means pre-k, kindergarten, first
11 grade, second grade and third grade;

12 4. "Play" means the spontaneous activity of children;

13 5. "Play-based learning" means any learning activities that are
14 performed by a child for self-amusement that have behavioral, social
15 and psychomotor rewards. Play-based learning shall also mean
16 activities that are child-directed, joyful and spontaneous whereby
17 the rewards come from within the individual child;

18 6. "Professional development" means any of a wide variety of
19 specialized training, formal education or advanced professional
20 learning intended to help administrators, teachers, and other
21 educators improve their professional knowledge, competence, skill
22 and effectiveness;

1 7. "Reading for pleasure" means reading that is freely chosen
2 or that readers freely and enthusiastically continue after it is
3 assigned; and

4 8. "Socialization" means social interaction with others.

5 C. Instruction in support of early childhood education
6 standards may be engaging and may foster children's development and
7 learning in all domains, including physical, social, emotional,
8 cognitive and language. To the best of their ability, educators may
9 create a learning environment that facilitates child-directed
10 experiences based upon developmentally appropriate early childhood
11 practices and intentional, sustained, play-based learning
12 opportunities, including, but not limited to, movement, creative
13 expression, exploration, socialization, reading for pleasure, art,
14 music and dramatic play. The art instruction may adhere to pre-k
15 standards for fine arts, which include dance, drama, music and
16 visual arts, as approved by the State Department of Education.
17 Educators may develop physical, social, emotional, cognitive and
18 academic learning opportunities in all curricular domains, which may
19 include unstructured time for the discovery of each child's
20 individual needs, abilities and talents.

21 D. In support of play-based learning in Oklahoma public
22 schools, school districts may provide ongoing early childhood
23 professional development for early childhood educators and
24 administrators, which may include existing early childhood

1 professional development programs from the State Department of
2 Education.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
