9	An Act relating to schools; defining term; requiring
10	biennial administration of the Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment Survey by the Department of

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-157 of Title 70, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. The "Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment Survey" means the
20	biennial mental health prevention survey of public and private
21	school students in grades 6, 8, 10 and 12 managed by the Department
22	of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.
23	B. Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year, and biennially
24	thereafter, public schools shall administer the Oklahoma Prevention

Needs Assessment Survey for the purpose of providing direction to
 schools, school districts and communities to effectively improve the
 lives of students regarding a variety of issues with a focus on
 alcohol, tobacco, other drug use, mental health, academic failure
 and violence.

C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
shall maintain the Oklahoma Prevention Needs Assessment Survey and
shall provide technical assistance for schools in survey
administration, reporting, planning and development of school mental
health prevention and intervention strategies informed by the survey
results.

D. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and the State Department of Education may promulgate rules as necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
