6                                   AS INTRODUCED

7                   An Act relating to initiative and referendum;  
8                   authorizing certain registered voters to use certain  
9                   address to sign initiative and referendum petitions;  
10                  providing for codification; and providing an  
11                  effective date.

12   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
14   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3.2 of Title 34, unless there is  
15   created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16           Registered voters signing an initiative or referendum petition  
17   who are certified by the Office of the Attorney General as  
18   participants in the Address Confidentiality Program established by  
19   Section 60.14 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes may use the  
20   address given to the registered voter by the Office of the Attorney  
21   General to sign an initiative or referendum petition.

22           SECTION 2.   This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
