12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.8 of Title 57, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	The Department of Corrections shall provide employees of the
17	Department one fifteen-minute break within the first eight (8) hours
18	worked and one additional fifteen-minute break every two (2) hours
19	thereafter. A supervisor of the Department shall not have the
20	discretion to deny a reasonable break or rest period during the
21	workday or regular shift period of an employee.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
