10                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11           An Act relating to schools; requiring certain schools  
12           to include certain information on pupil  
13           identification cards; stating intent of the  
14           Legislature to require institutions of higher  
15           education to include certain information on student  
16           identification cards; allowing schools and  
17           institutions of higher education to issue unused  
18           pupil and student identification cards; providing  
19           applicability; providing for codification; and  
20           providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
23           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.200A of Title 70, unless  
24           there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

          A.   Beginning July 1, 2021, a public school, including a charter  
          school that serves any pupils in seventh grade to twelfth grade and

1 issues pupil identification cards, shall have printed on either side  
2 of the pupil identification cards the telephone number described in  
3 paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either side  
4 of the pupil identification cards the telephone numbers described in  
5 paragraph 2 of this subsection:

6 1. The telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention  
7 Lifeline; and

8 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME  
9 to 741741.

10 B. It is the intent of the Legislature that, beginning July 1,  
11 2021, a public or private institution of higher education that  
12 issues student identification cards may have printed on either side  
13 of the student identification cards the telephone number described  
14 in paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either  
15 side of the student identification cards the telephone numbers  
16 described in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this subsection:

17 1. The telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention  
18 Lifeline;

19 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME  
20 to 741741; and

21 3. The campus police or security telephone number or, if the  
22 campus does not have a campus police or security telephone number,  
23 the local nonemergency telephone number.

1 C. As of January 1, 2021, if a school subject to the  
2 requirements of subsection A of this section, or a public or private  
3 institution of higher education subject to the requirements of  
4 subsection B of this section, has a supply of unissued pupil or  
5 student identification cards that do not comply with the  
6 requirements of subsections A and B of this section, as applicable,  
7 the school or the public or private institution of higher education  
8 shall issue those pupil or student identification cards until that  
9 supply is depleted.

10 D. Subsections A and B of this section shall apply to a pupil  
11 or student identification card issued for the first time to a pupil  
12 or student, and to a pupil or student identification card issued to  
13 replace a damaged or lost pupil or student identification card.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
