9 An Act relating to criminal procedure; authorizing
10 peace officers to stop and detain persons under
11 certain circumstances; requiring detained person to
12 provide certain information; authorizing further
13 detention if necessary; providing for the release or
14 arrest of detained person; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 212 of Title 22, unless there is
19 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A peace officer may stop any person who the peace officer
21 reasonably suspects is committing, has committed or is about to
22 commit a violation of the criminal laws of this state or the
23 criminal ordinances of a municipality and may require the person to
24 give his or her name and address and photo identification, if
 available. Any person who fails to identify himself or herself and

1 explain his or her actions to the satisfaction of the peace officer
2 may be further detained and further questioned and investigated by
3 the peace officer. At the end of the detention period, the person
4 so detained shall be released unless arrested and charged with a
5 crime.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
